**Trinity Celebrates Five Year Anniversary with Corporate
Rebrand and Relocation**

New Corporate I.D. Symbolizes Company's Focus on Growth and Upward Mobility

Since 2009, Trinity has completed eight projects in New York City, including the build out of the famous seafood landmark, Oceana restaurant, which earned the team a “Best of 2009 Project” award from *McGraw Hill*.

“We’re extremely proud of all we’ve accomplished in a short period of time,” said David Story, Trinity partner and founder. “We have successfully forged long term partnerships with clients, architects, and subcontractors, we’ve grown into new markets and most importantly, we’ve consistently conducted our business with integrity and placed our clients first.”
